Avelo Airlines Announces Nonstop Service to Washington, D.C.'s Dulles International Airport

Introductory one-way fares to D.C. start at \$46 IAD will serve as Avelo's 26 nonstop route from HVN, the most in Connecticut

NEW HAVEN, Conn.; May 21, 2024 – Avelo Airlines announced today it will introduce nonstop service this summer between Southern Connecticut's most convenient airport – Tweed-New Haven Airport (HVN) – and Washington, D.C.'s Dulles International Airport (IAD). Avelo is the only airline offering nonstop service between Southern Connecticut and Washington, D.C.

Beginning July 12, 2024, Avelo will operate this route twice weekly on Mondays and Fridays, utilizing Boeing Next-Generation 737 aircraft. Introductory one-way fares between IAD and HVN start at \$46*. Travelers can make reservations at AveloAir.com.

Avelo is distinguished by industry-leading reliability. In 2023, the airline achieved the lowest flight cancellation rate (0.2%) in the U.S. airline industry and ranked #2 in on-time performance with 82.8% of all Avelo flights arriving at their destinations within 15 minutes of their scheduled arrival time – the Department of Transportation's (DOT) standard metric for reporting on-time performance in the U.S. airline industry known as A14. In April 2024 Avelo ranked #1 in on-time performance and achieved the lowest flight cancellation rate among all U.S. carriers. These results are reported by Anuvu's third-party data platform. Anuvu is utilized by *The Wall Street Journal* for the publication's annual best and worst airline ranking.
