WILMINGTON, N.C.; June 27, 2024 — Avelo Airlines today celebrates its two-year anniversary of service at Wilmington International Airport (ILM). Since the airline began service at ILM two years ago, Avelo has flown nearly 100,000 Customers on more than 750 flights. This milestone is a validation of the airline's commitment to growing at ILM and the industry-leading affordability, reliability and convenience Avelo has introduced to Wilmington and Carolina Beaches travelers.

Avelo currently serves six nonstop destinations from ILM: Southern Connecticut's most convenient airport — Tweed-New Haven Airport (HVN), Washington, D.C. / Baltimore (BWI), Philadelphia / Delaware Valley (ILG) and three Florida destinations: Fort Lauderdale (FLL), Orlando (MCO) and Tampa (TPA).

Avelo Founder and CEO Andrew Levy said, "Since arriving at ILM two years ago, Avelo has introduced travelers in the Wilmington area to a new era of affordability, convenience and industry-leading reliability. Today's milestone demonstrates the appeal our low fares, nonstop flights to popular destinations, and friendly service are having with travelers throughout the region. ILM Airport Director Jeff Bourk said, "It's been great to see Avelo continue to grow their service at ILM. What started off as two routes has now grown to six convenient nonstops with everyday low fares. We're thankful Avelo continues to invest in ILM and offer more choices to fly nonstop to the northeast and Florida."

Avelo has also achieved industry-leading reliability at ILM. When excluding weather-related cancellations outside Avelo's control, the airline achieved a 99.3% completion rate, meaning the airline canceled less than 0.7% of flights at ILM since fruition. In May, the airline also ranked #1 in on-time performance and delivered the lowest flight cancellation rate in the industry – the second straight month Avelo led the industry in both metrics. Additionally, for the first five months of 2024, Avelo climbed to #1 in on-time performance and maintained the second-lowest flight cancellation rate among all U.S. carriers.
